Subject: The Governor's Regulatory Review Plan, Memorandum dated January 22, 2009

The Secretary of State's office received a memorandum from Governor Janice K. Brewer in regards to her Regulatory Review Plan. This memorandum is published in this week's *Arizona Administrative Register* as a Notice of Public Information on page 241. The *Arizona Administrative Register* will still be published weekly to include county notices, Governor Proclamations and Executive Orders and other information required under Arizona law.

This memorandum requires your agency to withdraw proposed rulemaking filings. Filings can be those already published in the *Arizona Administrative Register*, or those that were slated for publication under our deadline schedule.

The memorandum is clear that agencies are tasked to withdraw proposed filings. Please have your rulewriter contact Kim Crawford at (602) 364-3223 at his or her earliest convenience to have the rulemaking filings returned.

If a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking has already been published in the *Arizona Administrative Register* and your agency is withdrawing the filing under Governor Memorandum, dated January 22, 2009, we ask that a Notice of Public Information be filed to notify the public that your agency is withdrawing the filing. Also, please remember to cancel any public hearings about the Notice and have your rulewriter file a Notice of Public Information about the meeting cancellation. An outline of the Notice is posted on our website, www.azsos.gov under the Publications link.
